OUR VISION

Christian International School of Prague (CISP) was established in 2004 to provide an affordable, quality education in the English language, with a distinctively Christian perspective for students from kindergarten through high school.

Our purpose is to provide an education that is academically excellent, relationally nurturing and practically oriented. We intentionally equip students with a biblical perspective designed to assist them to know God better. In addition, we encourage and give opportunities for students to serve and transform their community for Christ.

We seek to develop our students' academic skills in analysis and effective communication as well as the integration of biblical principles into their worldview. While American curriculum is the model, our teaching staff is flexible in meeting the requirements of international students who may seek further schooling in other countries.



A SENSE OF COMMUNITY

The low student-teacher ratio at the Christian International School of Prague encourages a sense of community within our busy world. Our staff values each student's personal growth spiritually, mentally, emotionally, socially, and physically, creating a classroom atmosphere that is positive and encouraging. The parents are key players as they provide input into the broad vision as well as the daily life of the school.

OUR PROGRAM

For ages 6 – 18, we offer a variety of educational services to fit schooling needs. Most of our students participate in our full-time daily program, but we have many who capitalize on our individual course offerings. Guidance counseling is available to help secondary students prepare for further education.

Students have access to computer and science labs, two gyms, an all-weather outdoor recreation court, as well as a lunchroom that provides low-cost hot meals. The Czech school staff has been very kind and accommodating in this unique cross-cultural partnership.
