



Tuition and Fees 2017-2018

Tuition and Required Fees

Application Fee: A non-refundable fee of 2 000 CZK is required of all *new students* at the time of application (not included in the table below). This fee is for all applicable achievement, entrance or readiness testing.

Registration Fee: A non-refundable fee of 3 000 CZK is required of all students at the time of application (not included in the table below). This fee secures your enrollment in the school and covers all registration and orientation expenses.

*The actual cost to educate a child at CISP exceeds 300 000 CZK, but due to the commitment of our staff to raise their own financial support and the generosity of those who support them, CISP is able to offer an excellent education at an affordable rate for our families.

Notes:

Capital Fee:	The CISP Administrative Board has established an annual Capital Fee. Funds will be set aside for the acquisition of a building or other capital expenditures.
Activity Fee:	These mandatory fees support the activities that are an essential part of the educational program CISP provides. These activities include local field trips, designated overnight/day trips, spring class trips and graduation for 12th grade students.
Technology Fee:	All 9th-12th grade students will be provided with a Google Chromebook for educational use for each of their 9th -12th grade academic years.
School Supplies Fee:	All internal school supplies will be supplied for each 1st - 6th grade student through the school supplies fees. Supplies include: tissues, glue, notebook paper, erasers, pencils, markers, colored pencils, crayons, highlighters, cleaning wipes, etc.
Other Tuition Reductions:	For each additional child from the same family attending CISP during the same academic year, there is a reduction of 20% from tuition only. CISP teacher, aide and staff reductions are also available. Only one type of reduction can be applied for each family.
Partial Scholarships:	Tuition scholarships based on financial need are available on a limited basis and may be applied for after submitting the required application documents.

Additional Services:

CISP offers additional classes and opportunities for English Language Learning (ELL), educational therapy (Discovery Program), sports teams, as well as Advanced Placement (AP) courses for high school students preparing for university.
