



Tuition and Required Fees

Application Fee: A non-refundable fee of 4 000 CZK is required of all *new students* at the time of application (not included in the table below).

Enrollment Fee (new students only): A non-refundable fee of 6 000 CZK required of all *new students* at the time of acceptance (not included in the table below). Receipt of this fee secures your space in the school and covers all enrollment and orientation expenses.

Annual Registration Fee (returning students only): A non-refundable fee of 4 000 CZK is required of all returning students at the time of re-enrollment (not included in the table below).

*The actual cost to educate a child at CISP exceeds 350 000 CZK, but due to the commitment of our staff to raise their own financial support and the generosity of those who support them, CISP is able to offer an excellent education at an affordable rate for our families.

Notes:

School Fees Include:	Capital Fee:	The CISP Administrative Board has established an annual Capital Fee. Funds will be set aside for the acquisition of a building or other capital expenditures.
	Activity Fee:	These mandatory fees support the activities that are an essential part of the educational program CISP provides. These activities include local field trips, designated overnight/day trips, spring class trips and graduation for 12th grade students.
	Technology Fee:	All students will have daily access to a designated Chromebook. Students in 1st-8th grade will not be permitted to take the Chromebooks home, except in a distance learning situation. All 9th-12th grade students will be provided with a Google Chromebook for educational use for each of their 9th -12th grade academic years. They are allowed to take their Chromebooks home as needed.
	School Supplies Fee:	Most internal school supplies will be provided for each student from this fee. Elementary supplies include: tissues, glue, notebook paper, erasers, pencils, markers, colored pencils, crayons, highlighters, cleaning wipes, etc. Secondary supplies include: ISIC card fees, MS Trapper/HS Organizers, Math binders, and cleaning wipes (paper, pencils and other basic supplies not included).

Other Tuition Reductions: For each additional child from the same family attending CISP during the same academic year, there is a reduction of 10% from tuition costs only. CISP teacher, aide and staff reductions are also available. Other than Foundational Scholarships, only one type of reduction can be applied for each family.

Foundational Scholarships: Each student attending CISP that possesses and provides a current Czech passport or občanka will receive a reduction of 5% from tuition costs only. Foundational scholarships may be combined with any other tuition discount or scholarship.

Partial Scholarships: Tuition scholarships based on financial need are available on a limited basis and may be applied for only after; either completing the re-enrollment process or applying for admission and receiving an official acceptance letter from CISP.

Additional Services

CISP offers additional classes and opportunities for English Language Learning (ELL), educational therapy (Discovery Program), as well as Advanced Placement (AP) courses for high school students preparing for university.

Payment of Tuition and Fees

All families both new and returning are required to sign the annual Financial Obligation Contract as part of the enrollment/re-enrollment process. Parents may select which payment plan they prefer in this contract. Payment is accepted in either Czech crowns (CZK), Euros, or US Dollars, using cash or bank transfer. If paying in Euros or USD, the exchange rate of CNB (www.cnb.cz) on the day CISP receives payment will be used to determine the amount applied to tuition. Annual tuition/fees may be paid by any one of the following three plans:

- *One total payment, on or before 15 August
- *Two semester payments, on or before 15 August and 15 January
- *Four quarterly payments, on or before 15 August, 15 October, 15 January, and 15 March

Payments should appear in the account on or before the date specified. All late payments will be subject to a .05% late charge per day
